DISTRICT 50 HAWAII LIONS HALL OF FAME

PURPOSE:

To recognize and honor those Lions who have had a profound and lasting impact on our District. To acknowledge those who have distinguished themselves through their commitment, dedication and service through their Club, District and Lions Clubs International, to fulfill the mission and the motto of our Association – “WE SERVE”.

CRITERIA:

For inclusion into the Hall of Fame (HOF), the recipient must have demonstrated the following criteria:

- Tenure of Service and Commitment – must be/or have been a member in good standing with a minimum of ten (10) years of active service.
- Leadership and Mentorship – demonstrated outstanding leadership, held significant positions and roles, and inspired and mentored others within the District.
- Major Contributions and Innovations in Service – significantly led or contributed to existing programs, or introduced new and meaningful projects, that enhanced the District’s service to the community.
- District and International Impact – attended District and Lions International Conventions, USA/Canada Forums, recognizing the inclusive and global aspect of the Association.
- Awards and Recognition – consideration given for significant Lions awards and honors earned and received by nominee.
- Donations – consideration given for donations made to Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCIF) and/or Hawaii Lions Foundation (HLF) by the nominee.

PROCESS:

- 1) A candidate can be nominated by any Lion, Club or Zone within the District, with each permitted only one nomination per year.
- 2) The nomination must include: (A) letter of nomination from the sponsoring Lion, Club or Zone;
(B) completed Hall of Fame (HOF) application form;
(C) nonrefundable application fee of \$ 50.00.
- 3) The written application must be submitted to the Chairperson, Hall of Fame Committee, Hawaii Lions Foundation, at least 90 days prior to the start of the annual District Convention.
- 4) The applications will be verified and tallied for accuracy and completeness. Qualifying nominations will be reviewed and discussed by the HOF Committee, and candidates recommended for approval by the Board of Trustees.
- 5) The HOF award recipients are to be inducted into the HOF at the annual meeting of the Foundation, held during the District Convention.

HISTORICAL or POSTHUMOUS NOMINATIONS:

To recognize and honor those long after their active years of service or after their deaths, consideration and criteria will be made for their inclusion into the Hall of Fame, on a historical or posthumous basis. The nominee must have been inactive or deceased for five (5) or more years to qualify for this category of induction.

The criteria and process as outlined previously must be followed, however the minimum number of points necessary to qualify as calculated in Scoring Sheet (A) may be waived, due to the possible difficulty in obtaining the necessary information and documentation. In these cases, the supporting information form and the letter of support, items (B) and (C) of the application, will be critical in the success or denial of the application.

All other provisions of the application must be followed and submitted for consideration by the Hall of Fame Committee.

AWARD:

The inductee shall receive a District 50 Hawaii Hall of Fame plaque and the "Ambassador of Aloha" award in recognition of their induction into the District's Hall of Fame. In addition, a complete listing of all D-50 Hall of Fame recipients shall appear in the annual D-50 directory, and a perpetual plaque, with the names of all inductees and the year of their induction inscribed thereon.
